This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting minimum standards in Reading and Numeracy
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the upper two bands of Reading and Numeracy
- Develop teacher capacity through using current research, professional development and feedback
- Provide resources necessary to support initiatives and implement the Australian Curriculum

Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against year level standards
- Continue to expand oral language program
- Continue pre prep program
- Provide professional development, coaching and planning support to ensure teachers are able to engage with the Australian Curriculum: provide targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective teaching of essential concepts and skills in every classroom
- Continue partnership with High School to implement technology, coding and robotics

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ additional support staff (STL&N and teacher aides) to support early year's intervention. (\$70000)
- Provide resources to deliver explicit programs to address areas identified in school and student data as requiring development in line with goals. (\$4045)
- Continue to implement oral language programs in Pre/ Year 1 and targeted students. Employ speech therapist for additional hours. Continue to employ trained teacher aides to support program delivery. (\$20000)
- Provide planning days for teacher to engage in data discussions, professional conversations with Principal and HOC and coaching. (\$7000)
